Elk Township is located in the East Coast Corridor and is one of the 24 municipalities that make up Gloucester County, one of New Jersey's fastest growing counties. This almost 20 square mile township has State Highway Route 55, including an exit ramp and State Highway Route 77 within its boundaries. County Routes 538 and 553 also cross through the Elk Township. In addition, easy access to Interstate I295 and Route 322 is also available.

Quality of Life

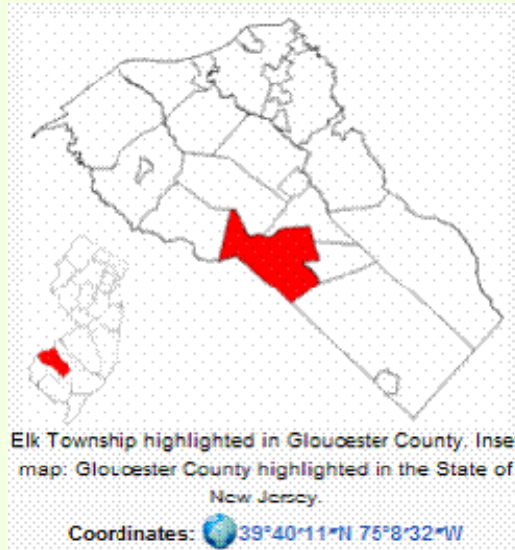
Elk Township has seen a gradual population increase over the past five years as people have seen the value of living in this growing community. 208 single family homes have been built since the year 2000 with many more waiting in the wings to begin construction. The Township's 2006 population estimate was 3,867.

The township boasts one of the first housing developments in the state offering solar assisted living.

The Township is proud to have its own Police Department, 3 Volunteer Fire Departments, an Elementary School and a Recreation Park as well as several recreation areas.

Convenient Location

There are numerous destinations located a short distance from Elk Township. Center City Philadelphia with its International Airport is a short 30 minute drive while Atlantic City and the Jersey shore are only an hour away. Even New York City is barely a two hour trip. Elk Township is located half way between New York and Washington D.C. with Delaware and Maryland also close by.
