POLICE CHIEF REPORT

Chief Hughes reported the department in the month of July received 875 calls for service, responded to 18 motor vehicle crashes with 9 injuries, issued 259 motor vehicle summons and made 16 arrests.

ENGINEER'S REPORT

Mr. Bitgood received approval from the NJDOT to advertise for bids for the reconstruction safety project on Stanger Avenue. The DOT will not participate in is the cleaning of the pipes.

Gas main replacement is ongoing in the Lawn's area. Mr. Bitgood has had a meeting with the gas company and the contractor concerning unsafe issues. They are back on track. He is going to require that an additional 5 year bond be posted or come up with a preventive correction plan.

Mrs. Nicholson asked if the township is registered with One-Call. Mr. Bitgood stated we are not, but should be.

Mr. Poisker asked if the HOA's are up to date with storm water requirements. Mr. Bitgood stated they have all been notified of the regulations and requirements. Some are submitting reports. The public works department is responsible for taking care of Township owned basins.
