COMMITTEE REPORTS

Mr. Hollywood attended the Delsea Regional Board of Education meeting. They approved hiring 12 new coaches and several new teachers. They are bringing back the Shop program.

Mrs. Nicholson thanked the Environmental Commission for planting the flowers in front of the municipal building and Lucas Greenhouses for the donation of the flowers.

POLICE CHIEF REPORT

Chief Hughes reported the police department received 709 calls for service, responded to 11 motor vehicle crashes with 2 injuries and 1 fatality. They issued 262 motor vehicle summons and made 10 arrests. Ptl. Frank Messina attended Alcotest initial course and Ptl. Franklin attended a crash school refresher.

FIRE DEPARTMENT REPORT

Mr. Rambo read the fire reports for the month of September. Aura Fire Company responded to 18 calls for service, Lawn's Fire Company responded to 2 calls and Ferrell Fire Company responded to 19 calls for service. Fire Prevention night is Wednesday, October 9th.

ENGINEER'S REPORT

Mr. Bitgood reported the Stanger Avenue project has received the order to proceed. There is a preconstruction meeting on October 7th. He is still waiting on a response from the bond company for Aura I. He is also waiting on which way to proceed with Aura II; push for bond or redevelopment.

Mr. Bitgood has not heard about the townships request to add certain areas to the sewer service area map. He will continue to call each week.

The purchase order has been approved and the planting of trees at the Vineyards can proceed.
