COMMITTEE REPORTS

Mr. Hollywood reported Aura School is considering the options to reopen in September. They are looking at $2 - \frac{1}{2}$ days in person learning.

Aura School will be holding 6th grade promotion on Monday, July 27, 2020 at 6pm in the park.

Mrs. Nicholson stated Environmental will be meeting in August. They are planning to add edging to the beds and plant bushes at the flag pole and monument in the front of the building.

POLICE CHIEF REPORT

Mr. Rambo read the police report for the month of June as submitted by Chief Hughes. The department received 1570 calls for service, responded to 14 accidents with 8 injuries, issued 6 motor vehicle summons and 4 warnings and made 1 arrest.

FIRE DEPARTMENT REPORT

Mr. Rambo read the Fire Company reports as submitted. Aura Fire Company, 39-1 responded to 20 calls for service and Ferrell Fire Company, 39-3 responded to 21 calls for service.

ENGINEER'S REPORT

Mr. Bitgood reported on a few highlights from his report.

The TCDI grant was approved in the amount of \$77,000.00. Looking for final contracts from DVRPC. This is for a bike way and pedestrian improvements.

Stanger Avenue core samples have been taken and this project can now be closed out without penalties. The final payment and change order will be submitted this month.

Aura I bond company contractor has been out and has made significant progress. Will be paving later this week or beginning of next, depending on weather.

Valle del Sol situation has not changed. He has worked up an estimate for the repair of the drainage problem. He will submit the plan to the DOT as part of the Ewan Road project. The NJ DEP is okay with this option.

Mr. Considine will have a bond ordinance prepared to potentially fund this portion of project. This way the funds will be available if it is not approved and funded by NJ DOT. The ordinance can be canceled if necessary.

Mr. Bitgood would like committee to review the ordinance concerning maintenance guarantees.
