TOPIC:

Governor Murphy signed into law 3 separate bills which legalize the possession and use of marijuana by adults over the age of 21, as well as regulate the enforcement and purchase/sale of recreational marijuana. William Caruso, Esq., of Archer and Greiner was asked by the Mayor to call in and give some guidance to committee on the new bills.

Mr. Caruso explained the rules on this are not yet known. Parental notification has been taken away from the police, however, there is currently a bill in review to change that.

Mr. Caruso stated that not allowing any type of operation, growing, processing or selling, does not prohibit the use in the township. Some things for committee to consider are, do you want it? where do you want it? and what tax rate do you want to charge?

There is a cap on the number of licensed growers that will be allowed in NJ at 36, currently there are 12. It was asked if there is any interference at the Federal level? Currently, yes, it is illegal on the Federal level.

The laws will also be changing on the testing of employees also.

If committee is considering they should think about where in the township this will be allowed.

Mr. Caruso is available if anyone has any questions moving forward.
