POLICE REPORT

Lt. Gonnelli gave the report for the police department for the month of March. The department received 1484 calls for service, issued 177 motor vehicle summons, responded to 8 motor vehicle crashes with 1 injury. There has been an increase in reports of shop lifting; additional foot patrols resulted in the apprehension of a shop lifting in progress.

Gloucester County Prosecutor, Christine Hoffman met with the Mayor, Mr. Rambo and members of the department. She want to personally thank Det. Pierson for his diligence regarding the involvement in the apprehension of a homicide suspect. The job that Det. Pierson was instrumental in the apprehension. Committee thank and commended Det. Pierson for the great job.

Operation Take Back (prescription medicines) will be held on April 24th from 10am to 2pm. There is a drop box in the municipal building that can be used during business hours year round.
