The Chief Financial Officer is directed to use this cash management plan as the guide in depositing and investing the Township of Elk's funds.

The following are authorized as suitable investments

- Interest bearing bank accounts and certificates of deposit in authorized banks, listed below, for deposit of local unit funds.
- Government money market mutual funds as comply with N.J.S.A. 40A:5-15.1(e).
- Any federal agency or instrumentality obligation authorized by Congress that matures within 397 days from the date of purchase, and has a fixed rate of interest not dependent on any index or external factors.
- Bonds or other obligations of the local unit or school district of which the local unit is a part.
- Any other obligations with maturities not exceeding 397 days, as permitted by the Division of Investments.
- Local Government investment pools which comply with N.J.S.A. 40A:5-15.1(e) and conditions set by the Division of Local Government Services.
- New Jersey Cash Management Fund.
- Repurchase agreements (repos) of fully collateralized securities which comply with N.J.S.A. 40A:5-15.1(a).

The following Government Unit Depository Protection Act approved banks are authorized depositories for deposit of funds

First National Bank of Elmer
Newfield National Bank
TD Bank, N.A.
Republic Bank, NA
PNC Bank, N.A.

The registered principal of any brokerage firm approved above shall be provided with and sign an acknowledgement that they have seen and reviewed the cash management plan.

Each month, the Chief Financial Officer shall prepare a report for the Governing Body that consists of the following:

- A summary of all investments made or redeemed
- Any and all financial institutions holding local unit funds
- The class or type of securities purchased or funds deposited
- Income earned on deposits and investments
- Market value of investments and disclosure and how the value was determined
- A listing of accounts or deposits that do not earn interest

The approved cash management policy is an integral part of this document.

Any official involved with the selection of depositories, investments, broker/dealers shall disclose any material business or personal relationship to the governing body and to the Local Finance Board.

Any official who in the course of his or her duties deposits or invests with the plan shall be relieved of any liability for loss of investment.

WHEREAS, the Act does not limit the discretion of a public body to permit, prohibit or regulate the act of participation of the public at a meeting;

WHEREAS, the Township Committee has historically allowed members of the public to address the Committee in order to permit and encourage public participation at such meetings;

WHEREAS, the Committee has determined that the enactment of rules and regulations for the conduct of such meetings and public participation would help clarify the process and encourage the public to participate in Township business;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Elk, in the County of Gloucester and State of New Jersey that the following rules shall be applied to all public comment portions of the meeting:

(1) The public is invited to attend and observe all public meetings of the Township Committee. Persons shall be heard at any public meeting as provided herein.


(2) At any public meeting for which a member of the public has properly requested to address Committee, such person may address the Committee as to the purpose set forth in the request to speak. After acknowledgment from the Mayor, each person to address Committee must state his or her name and residence or business address. Members of the public are limited to a three minute time limit to address Committee. The time limit does not apply (1) to persons invited by the Committee to address the respective governing body, or (2) to the extent said person is responding to a question posed by Committee member. The Mayor may restrict or limit the time allotted to a person whose remarks are repetitive or not germane to the matter under consideration by Committee. At meetings with unusually large attendance, the Mayor may impose such additional rules or time limitations as are deemed appropriate from time to time based on business before the Committee and the number of persons wishing to speak.

(3) Members of the public are not permitted to ask questions of, or debate with, Committee unless permitted to do so by the Mayor. All remarks shall be addressed to the Committee as a body and not to any member thereof.

(4) No member of the public, or any other person in attendance at a meeting of Committee, shall engage in any personally offensive or abusive remarks or conduct. No person shall behave in any manner that is unruly, disruptive, or may endanger the health, safety, or welfare of said person or other members of the public, or otherwise act in a manner not in compliance with these rules. Any person violating the rules herein is subject to removal from the meeting if he or she refuses to comply after being advised to do so.




