Lt. Hitzelberger stated the department officers were asked to participate in the 2022 Summer Traffic Safety Campaign from June 1 to August 31 to combat the "100 Deadliest Days" on our nations highways and to make Elk Township a safer place to live, visit and pass through. The officers increased their presence on the streets through targeted traffic enforcement. During these 100 days, the department conducted 763 motor vehicle stops and 284 radar details. The Campaign was a great success. Based on the numbers over the last 5 years, excluding 2020, Elk Twp. averaged 50 crashed each year during that period. This year there were 35 crashes, a decrease of 30% compared to the last 5 years. The top 3 Officers were Dylan Warburton with 175 motor vehicle stops and radar detail, William Opdyke with 192 motor vehicle stops and radar details and the top honors go to Stephen Schanne with 286 motor vehicle stops and radar details. Congratulations to all the officers.

**GLOUCESTER COUNTY REPRESENTATIVE**, Dennis McNulty was present to assist with questions or concerns for the county.

Vernita Fraction, 500 Union St., has a drainage pipe in her front yard that is clogged. It has not been cleaned out by the county for a few years.

There was also someone shooting a gun(s) over the weekend and Ms. Fraction stated it seemed very close to her house and she was frightened.

Bob Clark, 484 Union St., stated he thinks they were shooting on Silvergate property. He has contacted them to see if they have given permission to anyone to hunt on the property. The Elk Twp police were also contacted and they are investigating the matter.

#### TOWNSHIP OF ELK ORDINANCE O – 9 – 2022

CAPITAL ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR ACQUISITION OF AN ELECTRONIC SIGN FOR THE MUNICIPAL BUILDING, BY AND IN THE TOWNSHIP OF ELK, IN THE COUNTY OF GLOUCESTER, STATE OF NEW JERSEY; APPROPRIATING \$35,000 THEREFOR FROM THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND TO PAY FOR THE COST THEREOF

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Elk, in the County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey (the "Township"), wishes to undertake the acquisition of an electronic sign for the municipal building in and for the Township (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the cost of said improvements or purposes is estimated to be \$35,000; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township desires to authorize the appropriation and expenditure of \$35,000 from the Capital Improvement Fund of the Township to undertake the Project.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ELK, IN THE COUNTY OF GLOUCESTER, STATE OF NEW JERSEY (a majority of the full membership thereof affirmatively concurring), AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The capital improvements or purposes described below are hereby authorized as general capital improvements to be undertaken by the Township. For the said improvements or purposes, there is hereby appropriated the amount of \$35,000 from the Capital Improvement Fund of the Township, to undertake the acquisition of an electronic sign for the municipal building, and all work, materials, equipment, labor and appurtenances necessary therefor or incidental thereto.

**SECTION 2.** The expenditure of the \$35,000 consisting of the appropriation of \$35,000 from the capital improvement fund, for the improvements or purposes set forth in Section 1 hereof is hereby authorized and approved. The Mayor, the Clerk, the Chief Financial Officer and any other official/officer of the Township are each hereby authorized and directed to execute, deliver and perform any agreement to undertake the improvement or purpose set forth herein and to effectuate the transaction contemplated hereby.

SECTION 3. The capital budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this capital ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith and a resolution in the form promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital programs as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services, New Jersey Department of Community Affairs is on file in the Office of the Clerk and is available for public inspection.

**SECTION 4.** This ordinance shall take effect immediately after final adoption and approval by the Mayor as described in N.J.S.A. 40:49-2.
