On December 19, 2022, the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey enacted revisions concerning the sale and possession of firearms and supplementing and amending various parts of the statutory law. This law, which was signed by Governor Phil Murphy on December 22, 2022, included changes to the fees for first time firearms ID card applicants, permits to purchase handguns and permits to carry firearms within the State of New Jersey. The Elk Township Police Department must be compliant to the revisions of this law. Part of our compliance will be collecting the proper fees for first time firearms ID card applicants, permits to purchase handguns, and permits to carry handguns within the State of New Jersey. Therefore, any application submitted on December 22, 2022, or later, will be subject to the fee schedule below:

All payments to be made to Elk Township must be submitted to the Elk Township Police Clerk, Ivan Moore during the following hours:

- Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday 08:30 A.M. to 4:30 P.M.
- Thursday 08:30 A.M. to 3:30 P.M.
